## Call for Secondary Credit Courses

The Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association (OCSTA) and Catholic Virtual Ontario (CVO) are currently accepting recommendations for high-quality courses modified and/or developed by Catholic educators in Catholic school boards. Parts or all of the submitted courses may be selected and considered for modification and/or augmentation by the selected Catholic Virtual Ontario writing teams.

Recommended courses for the following codes are now being accepted. Work on these courses will officially begin in the summer. It is anticipated that a call for writers will be distributed and writing teams will be selected later this month. It is also anticipated that the revised versions of these courses will be available to Catholic school boards in Ontario for fall 2024.
